If a student is registered for more than one subsession, the due dates will coincide with the earliest starting subsession. If tuition and fees are not paid by the due date, your registration will be cancelled and your classes will be dropped. If you are dropped for nonpayment, any future registration payments will be due within one business day.

You may pay your tuition and fees by cash, check, debit card, VISA, Mastercard, DiscoverCard, or American Express. Online payment processing is available through the MyDaytonaState Portal. Once you have logged in to the portal, click on the FalconNet tab and then on "Payment" on the left navigation menu and then click on Fee Statement - Make Payment.

Students who have submitted a valid FAFSA and ALL required documents prior to their bill due date and the Financial Aid priority deadline will have their bill automatically deferred. Students who have not submitted a valid FAFSA and have not submitted all requested documents prior to their bill due date and the Financial Aid priority deadline must make payment by the bill due date to avoid cancellation. Students who have an approved award but the award is not sufficient to cover all the charges, ie. Bright Futures or the Florida Prepaid College Program, should pay the remaining balance by the bill due date.

The College has partnered with Nelnet Business Solutions to provide the e-Cashier Payment Plan to assist with paying tuition. To enroll, log in to the MyDaytonaState portal, click on the FalconNet tab and then on "Payment" on the left navigation menu and then click on e-Cashier Payment Plan. Payments are made by automatic ACH transfers or by automatic credit card payments. No interest is charged but there is an enrollment fee of up to \$35 per semester.
